The **Executive Director, Academic Advising** (ED-AA) focuses on equitable access and opportunities for undergraduate students through coordinated support and training for the academic and co-curricular advising community at UC Davis. The ED-AA leads in partnership with the team from Academic Advising Enrichment, a unit in Undergraduate Education. As the primary campus expert on academic advising, the ED-AA must possess and apply indepth expertise with regard to policy and practice through a framework that enhances diversity, equity, and inclusion. The incumbent leverages this expertise to lead central campus initiatives to professionally develop academic advisors and advocate for diverse populations through advising.

- Advance the practice, delivery, and effectiveness of advising in academic programs and college deans' offices.
- Foster and expand the campus continuous learning model to ensure all advisors regularly engage in ongoing professional development.
- Lead senior management and planning committees in strategic approaches for advising policy and practice.
- Plan, develop, and implement new programs and organizational structure changes required to implement new policy.
- Provide mentorship to advising leaders and key projects/assessments.
